Perimeter is a Website for the Public

• Perimeter Platform was contracted to create and maintain a <u>website</u> for El Dorado County

- •Access: perimetermap.com or the QR code
- •Basic purpose:
 - Shows citizens if there is an evacuation that impacts them
 - Identified evacuation routes
- •Your location on the map is shown as a blue dot
- •Red and yellow colors show evacuation orders and warnings
- Green lines show evacuation routes
- •One, simple, easy to access site for county-wide information during evacuations



Perimeter Zones

County is divided up into multiple zones


Minim Learn the name of the zone you live in

When we send out an evacuation alert, we will use the name of the impacted zone(s)

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If you hear your zone is under an evacuation.... open perimetermap.com and see if you are affected by the evacuation

Evacuation Basics

 Primary method of conducting evacuations = Door to Door. Secondary = Rave alert & Perimeter

• During disasters there might not be power or cell service

 Evacuation Warning – Gives people who need more time to evacuate (elderly, disabled, large animals) more time to do so and it decreases the traffic on roads

 Evacuation Order – You must leave now, immediate risk to life

• Don't hesitate to leave if you feel that you need to evacuate, even if no direction has been given



Perimeter Example


<u>Red</u> = Evacuation order zone

Blue Dot = My location on the map

<u>Yellow</u> = Evacuation warning zone

<u>Green Lines</u> = Evacuation Route

<u>Green House Icon</u> = Evacuation Shelter




Perimeter Example

<u>Red</u> = Evacuation order zone

<u>Yellow</u> = Evacuation warning zone

<u>Red Circle with a line through it =</u> Road closure

Enroll	Enroll in El Dorado County Emergency Alerts powered by Rave for timely notifications.
Website	Save the Perimeter website to easily access during emergencies. Know your zone.
Routes	Familiarize yourself with exit routes from your neighborhood. Drive these routes at least once to ensure readiness in case of evacuation.
Prepare	Prepare an evacuation kit with essential items such as medications and important documents.
Info	Obtain information solely from trusted and verified sources during emergencies, including the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office, Local Police Departments, CHP, El Dorado County, CAL FIRE, and local fire districts


