- 6. Trencamp retired has been trying to sell this vacant property for 3 years.
- 7. Rostin, retired, has granny residence for caregiver son.
- 8. Leonard, widow, house up for sale pending foreclosure
- 9. Waldron, retired
- 10. Fiske, retired, has 2 wells
- 11. Gregoire, retired, has 2 wells and a holding tank.
- 12. Fulster, has bad well can't water in the summer can't run appliances at the same time
- 13. Barnikel, retired
- 14. Mills, retired, has 2 wells and a holding tank
- 15. Felton, widow
- 16. McComb, well
- 17. Bourriague, house has been foreclosed on still in house pending eviction.

So, as you can see any loss of well water caused by "Sundance" could well devastate this neighborood and alter the quality of life for it's property owners.

It is just not right to approve this land split, in fill, re-zone, from its existing AG designation. The developer, Chris Beauchamp, needs to bring in GDPUD water. Please vote to oppose this project. It is just not good for Pilot Hill.
