



RESOLUTION NO. 105-2016

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, the mission of People to People International, together with its local chapters, is to enhance international understanding and friendship through educational, cultural, and humanitarian activities involving the exchange of ideas and experiences directly among peoples of different countries and diverse cultures; and the vision is that a cross-cultural network of engaged and knowledgeable everyday citizen leaders will be an active force in creating and sustaining a more peaceful world; and

**WHEREAS**, at its June 7, 2016 meeting, the Board of Supervisors heard Agenda item 16-0610, a presentation from a representative of the El Dorado Chapter of People to People International, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, presenting its plan to host a contingent of visitors from El Dorado County's Sister City of Warabi, Japan, as part of its Youth Summit 2016 exchange program; and

**WHEREAS**, El Dorado County (County) wishes to encourage tourism, agriculture, and economic development in the County by supporting promotional, cultural, and community activities; and

**WHEREAS**, County has appropriated funding for the purpose of providing assistance to entities that support promotional, cultural, and community activities throughout the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has identified funding for a one-time contribution to the El Dorado Chapter of People to People International in the amount of \$4,250.00 assist the El Dorado Chapter of People to People Internatioal to fund planned activities of the Youth Summit 2016 exchange program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors has determined that a public benefit is derived from the support of the Youth Summit 2016 exchange program;

**WHEREAS**, the funding provided herein will provide a valuable public service that will promote cultural, economic, and historical preservation activities which enhance tourism and encourage a sense of community to the people of the County; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado directs the Auditor-Controller to disburse funding in the amount of \$4,250.00 to the El Dorado Chapter of People to People International for the purpose of supporting the Youth Summit 2016 exchange program with the County's Sister City of Warabi, Japan.


