**Resolution for Road Closure for the
“Garden Valley 4th of July Parade and Celebration”**

WHEREAS, The Georgetown Divide Recreation District (Sponsor) desires to hold the “Garden Valley 4th of July Parade and Celebration” on Monday, July 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said Sponsor has applied for a Road Closure Permit pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code §12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution 110-79 in order to promote the “Garden Valley 4th of July Parade and Celebration” on Monday, July 4, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Marshall Road between Greenwood Road and Garden Valley Road on Monday, July 4, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., for the “Garden Valley 4th of July Parade and Celebration,” subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979.

This Resolution and the “Special Event Permit Application” with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the road closure “Special Event Permit.”
