

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 5260 ADOPTING AUTOMATED  
POINT-OF-SALE REGULATION

The Board of Supervisors, on May 12, 2026, approved an Ordinance that would establish a regulatory program for the County Sealer of Weights and Measures to register and inspect point-of-sale systems pursuant to Business and Professions Code 13350 et seq. The Ordinance will require businesses using point-of-sale systems to register with the County Sealer annually, pay an annual registration fee, be subject to delinquency penalties, and re-inspection fees. In addition, the County Sealer will inspect all point-of-sale systems under a schedule determined by the County Sealer, including re-inspections. The Ordinance is effective 30 days after final adoption by the County Board of Supervisors.
