

What is the estimated purchase price and are existing structures and recreational facilities included?

Is there, or will there be, a Letter of Intent to make the Forebay property a Pollock Pines Community Park?

Would such a park require a Mitigated Negative Declaration and Initial Study such as was done for the proposed Sanders Drive Community Park?

If the intent is to obtain the Forebay property for a park are there plans to accept the property as is? ... make modifications? ... add or remove facilities?

If the intent is to obtain the Forebay property for a park does the County assume responsibility for operational matters such as public safety, maintenance, utilities, etc.?

If the intent is to obtain the Forebay property for a park, how does the Commission propose to work with and address operational matters with existing users of the property? ... Snowline Little League? ...Pollock Pines Horseshoes Club? ...users of the former Senior Center building?
