WHEREAS, the Mother Lode Union School District ("MLUSD") and the Placerville Union School District ("PUSD") share a common boundary between the two school districts; and

WHEREAS, the MLUSD and the PUSD have determined that the reorganization of the boundaries between both school districts in the Placerville area is in the best interests of the community; and

WHEREAS the Education Code Sections 35700 *et seq.* provide a process for the districts to reorganize the boundaries of the districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The MLUSD hereby submits this petition to the county superintendent of schools for the reorganization of the boundaries between the MLUSD and the PUSD pursuant to Education Code Section 35700(d).
2. The reorganization of the boundaries is in the Placerville area encompassed by both school districts and maps showing the current boundary and the proposed new boundary are attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".
3. Pursuant to Education Code Section 35709(b)(2), this Board has determined that the petition is to transfer inhabited territory of less than 10 percent of the assessed valuation of the district from which the territory is being transferred. This Board has further determined pursuant to Education Code Section 35709 that this petition substantially meets the conditions enumerated in paragraphs (1) through (10) of the Education Code Section 35753. Section 35753 provides as follows:
 - (a) The State Board of Education may approve proposals for the reorganization of districts, if the board has determined, with respect to the proposal and the resulting districts, that all of the following conditions are substantially met:
 - (1) The new districts will be adequate in terms of number of pupils enrolled.
 - (2) The districts are each organized on the basis of a substantial community identity.
 - (3) The proposal will result in an equitable division of property and facilities of the original district or districts.
 - (4) The reorganization of the districts will not promote racial or ethnic discrimination or segregation.
 - (5) The proposed reorganization will not result in any substantial increase in costs to the state.

4. Items 4 & 5: Consideration and Deliberation on the Conditions of Education Code 35753
The County Committee discussed how to best proceed with taking action on each of the nine (9) conditions of Education Code 35753. It was agreed that each condition would be discussed and voted upon separately, as follows:
 - a. The organized districts will be adequate in terms of number of pupils enrolled
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
 - b. The districts are each organized on the basis of substantial community identity
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
 - c. The proposal will result in an equitable division of property and facilities of the original district or districts
The County Committee voted "Not applicable", as no property or facilities are involved.

- d. The reorganization of the district will preserve each affected district's ability to educate students in an integrated environment and will not promote racial or ethnic discrimination or segregation
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
- e. Any increase in costs to the state as a result of the proposed reorganization will be insignificant and otherwise incidental to the reorganization
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
- f. The proposed reorganization will continue to promote sound education performance and will not significantly disrupt the educational programs in the districts affected by the proposed reorganization
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
- g. Any increase in school facilities costs as a result of the proposed reorganization will be insignificant and otherwise incidental to the reorganization
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
- h. The proposed reorganization is primarily designed for purposes other than to significantly increase property values
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
- i. The Proposed reorganization will continue to promote sound fiscal management and not cause a substantial negative effect on the fiscal status of the proposed district or any existing district affected by the proposed reorganization
The County Committee voted in unanimous agreement.
