

AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES #097-110-P-E2010
AMENDMENT IV
Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Services

This Amendment IV to that Agreement for Services #097-110-P-E2010, made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as County) and Progress House, Inc., whose principal place of business is 2844 Coloma Street, Placerville, CA 95667, and whose Agent for Service of Process is Judy Marie Strauss, 2844 Coloma Street, Placerville, CA 95667; (hereinafter referred to as Contractor).

R E C I T A L S

WHEREAS, Contractor has been engaged by County to provide alcohol and other drug treatment services, in accordance with Agreement for Services #097-110-P-E2010, dated May 12, 2010; Amendment I to that Agreement dated December 7, 2010; Amendment II to that Agreement dated November 15, 2011; and Amendment III to that Agreement dated May 8, 2012, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Agency, Public Health Division (HHSA/PHD) has identified Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) funding in Amendment III erroneously added to Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2011-12 and desires to make it available for counseling and treatment services for FFY 2010-11; and

WHEREAS, HHSA/PHD shall reduce the SAPT Federal Block Grant Discretionary Funding for FFY 2011-12 by \$48,000, and increase SAPT Federal Block Grant Discretionary Funding for FFY 2010-11 by \$48,000, thereby amending Article IV – Compensation for Services, Section 4.02 – Amount of Funding, subparagraph (a) (ii);

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree that Agreement for Services #097-110-P-E2010 and all subsequent amendments thereto shall be amended a fourth time as follows:

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1) Article IV, Section 4.02 (a) (ii) shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(ii) For the term July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 is set forth below, by funding type:


