What We've Found...

*An abundance of needles recovered by HOT

- *Loaded and uncapped
- *SHRC products present at 2 overdose death
- *Drug use supplies readily available
- *Dealers obtaining needles, loading them and selling them



*CI reached out to SHRC for assistance finding services to end their addiction

*Were told there were no resources for rehab or Suboxone clinics

*Were provided drug use supplies, Fentanyl test kit, alcohol swabs, condoms and lip balm



Just a reminder that these are the services and supplies we offer at no charge: documentation, referrals to medical/dental/mental health care, Narcan, fentanyl test strips, wound care kits, smoking kits, hot rail kits, snorting kits, safer injecting kits, sharps containers, points (28s,29s, and 31s), and hygiene products like condoms, lube, pads, tampons. Overdose Deaths






209 El Dorado County Citizens living with AIDS

CHANGES IN THE LAWS

- Prop 47 and Prop 57
- Decriminalizing drug offenses
- Severity of property crimes reduced
- Diversion vs Sentencing for addictions

The El Dorado County Sheriff's Office remains a Total Enforcement agency and supports those reporting crimes

CHANGES IN ENFORCEMENT

- Corporate retailers have adopted policies to not enforce or report thefts
- Mail theft is still very prevalent but not always reported
