RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Protection Agency, California Integrated Waste Management Board will provide financial support for the Local Government Waste Tire Cleanup and Amnesty Event Grant Program Fiscal Year 2009/2010 to help divert waste tires from landfill disposal, prevent illegal tire dumping, and educate the public about waste tire recycling and proper tire maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will apply for said grant with the California Environmental Protection Agency, California Integrated Waste Management Board for the implementation of such grant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado:

Authorizes the Director of Environmental Management, or their designee, of the County of El Dorado, to apply, sign, execute and submit all necessary Local Government Waste Tire Cleanup and Amnesty Event Grant Program Fiscal Year 2009/2010 documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and payment requests to the California Protection Agency, California Integrated Waste Management Board to secure grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant.
