Subject El Dorado Disposal rate increase

I understand from a notice I received from El Dorado Disposal Service that a hearing has been scheduled before the Board of Supervisors on June 26, 2007, to review a requested "consumer price index" rate increase for El Dorado Disposal. My wife and I OPPOSE any such proposed rate increase.

As residents of Cameron Park we are forced to pay for mandatory trash service from El Dorado Disposal. I have been informed that by a slim majority vote mandatory trash service was approved by the voters. Any rate increase for mandatory service should likewise be approved by those same voters. The only matter the Board of Supervisors should consider involving mandatory trash service is whether or not those forced to pay for mandatory trash service should be forced to continue paying for mandatory service. Once service is no longer mandatory, them feel free to consider price increases.

El Dorado Disposal received a price increase less that six months ago. In November 2006 they were granted a \$1.60 per billing period fuel charge that the Board apparently approved without notice to rate payors. If we had received notice of the proposed fuel charge, you would have received notice of our opposition to that charge as well.

As tax payors and voters of El Dorado County, we are asking you to oppose any proposed rate increase and we ask that the fuel charge be eliminated as well.
