

PROCLAMATION

Of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado In Recognition of the Community Volunteers Who Support El Dorado County Animal Services

WHEREAS, as part of their Mission to promote the health and safety of people, their animals and the communities of El Dorado County, the El Dorado County Animal Services Program provides services to educate and protect county residents through the administration of programs that provide for the care, shelter, treatment, licensing, enforcement measures, and advocacy for companion animals and livestock; and,

WHEREAS, dedicated community volunteers donate their time, compassion, specialized knowledge and experience to support the daily operations at the West Slope and South Lake Tahoe animal shelters; as foster families who open their homes to care for animals with specialized needs; and as members of the Friends of the El Dorado County Animal Shelter who raise funds to provide vouchers for spay/neuter services, assistance with veterinary expenses, and to purchase equipment for the animal shelters; and,

WHEREAS, in 2017-18, over 165 community volunteers donated 7,549 hours to support the El Dorado County Animal Services Program provide shelter and care for the stray, unwanted or displaced animals housed in our shelters and to support efforts to secure permanent, loving homes for healthy and adoptable animals; and,

WHEREAS, the dedicated efforts of the volunteers who support the animal shelters are enhanced by their fellow community volunteers who also donate thousands of hours each year as foster care families and as members of the Friends of the El Dorado County Animal Shelter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby recognize the community volunteers who support the El Dorado County Animals Services Program in appreciation for their compassion and commitment to ensure that the residents of El Dorado County have access to resources to help them care for their companion animals and livestock and have opportunities to adopt healthy animals in need of a forever home.
