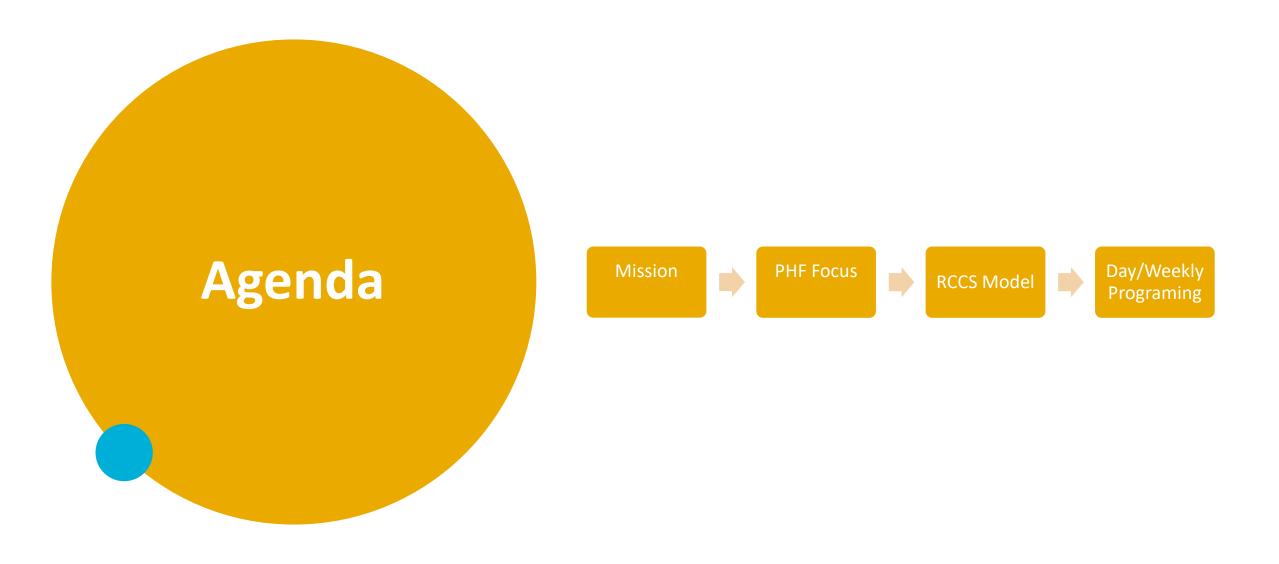

The Focus of Our El Dorado PHF Work

- Telecare has been devoted to the recovery of individuals who are most in need, those with complex behavioral health challenges. We have been part of the Placerville community at El Dorado PHF since 2015.
- We provide intensive mental health and psychiatric treatment services in a safe welcoming environment for adults experiencing a mental health emergency. We believe that recovery is a deeply personal experience.
- Our secure 16-bed facility has a multidisciplinary team that includes a psychiatrist, social workers, a rehabilitation therapist, registered nurses, recovery specialists, food services staff and peer support specialists.
- We are uniquely qualified to deliver successful results for the clients and communities we serve because of our comprehensive array of inpatient programing, our diverse professional workforce of employees, our recoverycentered clinical system, and our track record of doing whatever it takes to support a patients recovery journey during their time with us.

Recovery-Centered Clinical System (RCCS)

- Staff are trained in **Telecare's Recovery Centered Clinical System (RCCS)**, including the Recovery Conversations that encompass five components: identity, hope, choice, harm, and connection.
- Telecare's RCCS provides services that awaken each individual's hopes and dreams for a life worth living, while teaching skills that lead to self-control and self-responsibility.
- The RCCS incorporates evidence-based and best practices, including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT), Motivational Interviewing, Harm Reduction and Trauma Informed Care.

Daily Programing-Services & Supports

Services are provided directly by our staff; these include but are not limited to:

- Collaborative treatment planning with a recovery focus incorporating Personcentered and Trauma informed approach
- Comprehensive evaluation and risk assessment
- Daily Groups- Community council, Recreational therapy, medication support and education, coping, substance abuse, crisis planning etc.
- Nutrition- Integrated patient involvement in choices and options
- Supportive counseling on a group and Individual basis
- Discharge planning, including linkage with community services and support
