# Background

3

- **July 28, 2015**
  - The Board of Supervisors adopted a comprehensive sign ordinance update (Ordinance No. 5025), currently codified as Chapter 130.36 (Signs).
- **2016 - 2018**
  - After extensive engagement with the Cameron Park community, the Cameron Park Design Review Committee (DRC) completed preliminary drafts of the proposed sign standards, using the updated Chapter 130.36 as a starting point.
  - The most current draft standards, dated February 20, 2018, are included in the Legistar attachments for today's workshop.

  1. Existing County Code (Chapter 130.36 – Signs)
  2. Sign regulations of other jurisdictions
