PRE-PASSAGE SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 5084
Pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b)(1), the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado hereby gives notice that it will hear and vote on the final passage of Ordinance 5084, amending Chapter 9.55 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code addressing camping and storage of personal property on private and public property in El Dorado County on April 24, 2018. The amendment will add (1) County cemeteries; and (2) public property and conservation easements owned, maintained, or managed to preserve or mitigate the impacts to natural conditions, the environment, or habitats, including but not limited to habitat for Pine Hill Endemics or Oak Woodlands, to the list of locations where camping is prohibited in the County. The amendment will also memorialize an opportunity to request an informal hearing before unlawfully stored personal property is removed.
