Honorable Commission Members:

The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors respectfully submits the attached El Dorado County Resolution No. _____, as adopted by our Board on Monday, June 6, 2011, to request that the Counties of El Dorado and Placer remain within the same State Senate, State Assembly and State Board of Equalization Districts.

As outlined in the attached Resolution, the Counties of El Dorado and Placer share many demographic, geographic, and growth characteristics as well as physical geographic locations. We share a similar history as the discovery of gold in 1848 led to the mass migration to California that resulted in the establishment of mining settlements that led to the formation of our Counties. Today, this shared history remains as a fundamental piece of our identities and our future.

Our Board anticipates the release of the first round of preliminary district maps, and understands that as the public reviews and provides comment on the preliminary maps, the Commission can propose revisions that reflect the comments and recommendations made by the public until mid-August when the Commission is scheduled to certify the final maps and provide a report to the Secretary of State.

The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors requests that, as the Commission works through this process, you endeavor to allow the Counties of El Dorado and Placer to remain within the same State Senate, State Assembly, and State Board of Equalization Districts.
