DEPARTMENT SUMMARY AND REQUESTED BOARD ACTION:

County Ordinance Section 15.16.020 specifies that a building permit shall become null and void if the building or work is not completed with a final inspection approval within two years from the date of issuance. It is the practice of the Building Department to notify applicants of this regulation at least 30 days prior to expiration. Due to the fact that the church is a non-profit organization and has attempted to fund the project on a pay-as-you-go basis, the expiration time frame for an issued permit based on the County Ordinance has been exceeded. Supervisor Paine on behalf of the applicant has requested that the building permit be renewed for one year for a new expiration date of January 16, 2007.
