A. The good/service requested is restricted to one supplier for the reason stated below:

1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this goods/services supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively sourced. Explain how the supplier is the only source for the acquisition.)

The Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Behavioral Health (BH) division currently contracts with all vendors qualified to provide Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly (RCFE) in El Dorado County. Additional out of County contracts are necessary to meet the needs of eligible open clients receiving services through the Full Service Partnership project. HHSA, BH seeks to maintain these contracts due to client/clinician continuity of care. In accordance with County Ordinance 3.13.030 and the Welfare and Institutions Code Division 5, Part 2, Chapter 1 The Bronza-McCorquodale Act, 5600.3 (b).

2. Provide the background of events leading to this acquisition.

HHSA, BH is the designated Medi-Cal Mental Health Plan with the regulatory requirement to serve Medi-Cal adult beneficiaries with severe mental illness (SMI). RCFE provide necessary services for adults meeting SMI criteria in an inpatient residential environment. Grace Home II has provided the HHSA out of county RCFE via Agreement 5621 approved by the Board on September 21, 2021 (File ID# 21-0552). Previously Agreement 3132 was approved by the Board on August 14, 2018 (File ID# 18-0939), an Amendment approved on October 9, 2018 (File ID# 18-1398) and second Amendment on December 8, 2020 (File ID# 20-1440).

3. Describe the uniqueness of the acquisition. (Why was the goods/services supplier chosen?)

Grace Home II is licensed by the state of California to provide RCFE for adults with severe mental illness and was identified as an appropriate, reasonably local vendor. By contracting with Grace Home II, the County will have access to additional facilities in the state, located in Sacramento County. The County does not have the staff or facilities to provide RCFE for BH clients.

4. What are the consequences of not purchasing the goods/services or contracting with the proposed supplier?

Should the Board decline to approve this recommendation, HHSA would continue to provide services through contracts with other vendors. HHSA would, however, be limited in its capacity to provide RCFE services, and clients currently receiving services from Grace Home II will experience a disruption in the continuity of care. This would likely result in placement to a higher level of care, up to and including a Mental Health Rehabilitation Center/Institution for Mental Disease.

5. What market research was conducted to substantiate no competition, including the evaluation of other items or service providers? Maintaining a RCFE in as close a proximity as possible to the Behavioral Health office and other locations specific to EDC client services minimizes the need for additional travel expenditures as clients are often transported for psychiatric services.
B. Price Analysis:

CalAIM Payment Reform required drastic changes in the previous payment methodology. Cost analysis from all current vendors were required utilizing CalAIM provided templates. Provider costs were then evaluated by HHSA Fiscal as a percentage of the EDC Medi-Cal billing rates to ensure rates appropriately support the full provision of services for both the provider and the County.

Rate analysis have allowed the county to ensure services are provided at market rates.
