







Alert Wildfire Cameras

TPC coordinates implementation and funding of wildfire prevention cameras basin wide, protecting our communities, businesses and residents.



Google Foundation + Local Residents

We amplify local investments through collaborative partnerships with the Google Foundation and local residents.



LTCC Public Safety Center

TPC's economic data and support helped the recent award of \$8.6 million to build the new training complex.



CA State Implementation Funding

Leading efforts to help bring part of the \$120 million in CA Jobs First state funding to El Dorado County.

Sugar Pine Village

Two major housing projects that TPC contributed to achieved milestones by breaking ground. Sugar Pine had its first residents move in October 2024 as part of Phase 1.



LTCC Student Housing

LTCC originally applied for consideration for housing funding and was awarded with \$39.3 million just seven months later thanks to housing data and support from TPC.



County Coordination

TPC coordinates housing data and studies regionally to ensure efficiency and increased output that comes with collaboration and data sharing.



Placemate

TPC's housing data, needs assessments and action plans allow organizations like Placemate and others to provide housing options for local residents.

Host Regional Broadband Consortia Meetings

Lead agency for the Tahoe Region Broadband Consortium and facilitator of the Tahoe Basin Project recognized by the CPUC.



Coordinated Federal and State Funding

Helped El Dorado County gain information and support to access \$66.2 million in BEAD funding for completion of last and middle mile funding projects.



Goal: 98% of the Tahoe Basin has access to the Internet

Continued work and identification of areas that are in need of high speed internet service to reach the goal.



USDA + CPUC

TPC facilitates two major grants through the CPUC and USDA to facilitate broadband expansion in the Basin.

CA Jobs First

The Tahoe Prosperity Center is the El Dorado County Ambassador for California Jobs First. Current Catalyst fund projects available up to \$9 million.



Business Walks

Led the basin wide effort to connect with local businesses in person and via surveys for feedback on local needs.



CA State General Fund

We amplify this work by assisting and supporting with grants and projects that draw funds from the State of California to El Dorado County.



USDA Rural Development

TPC uses federal funds to ensure that efforts are coordinated throughout historically excluded communities in the basin and surrounding areas.
