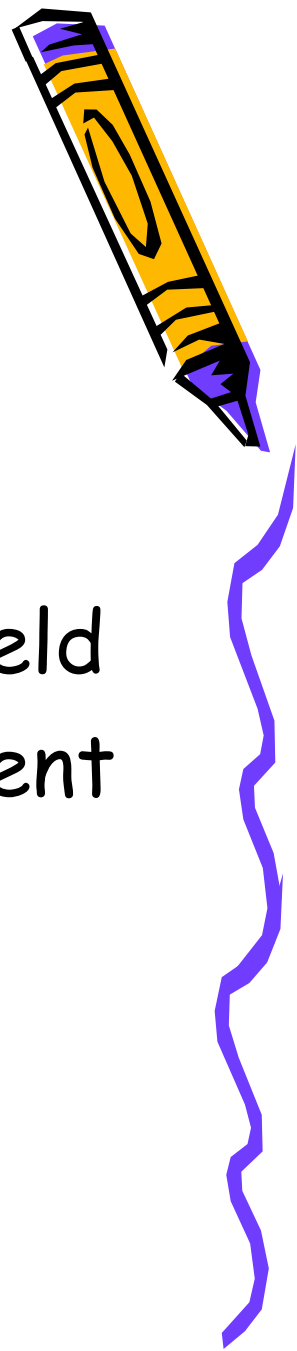


Measure Q Bond

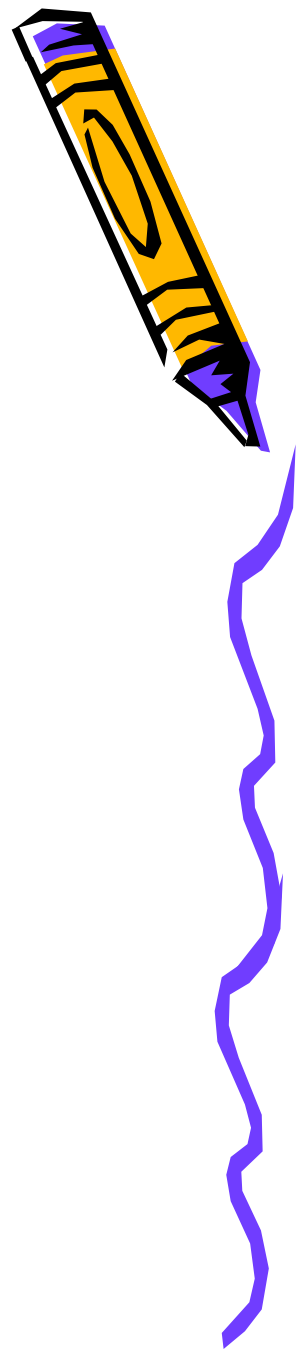

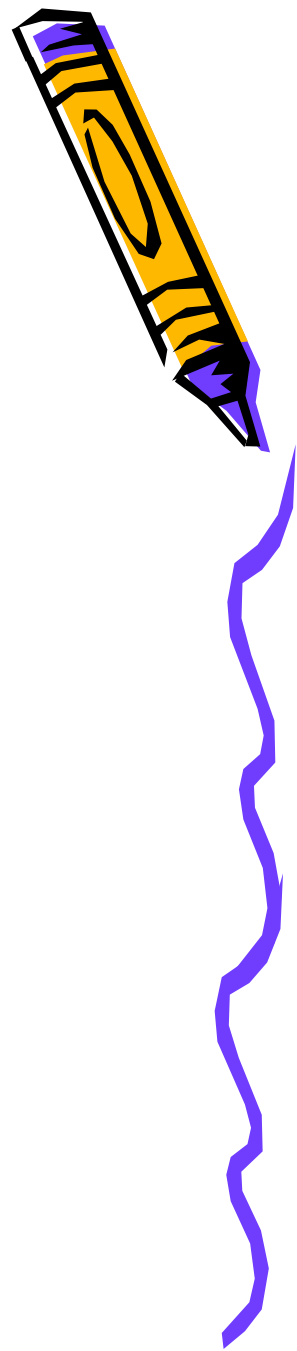
Culinary Arts Facility

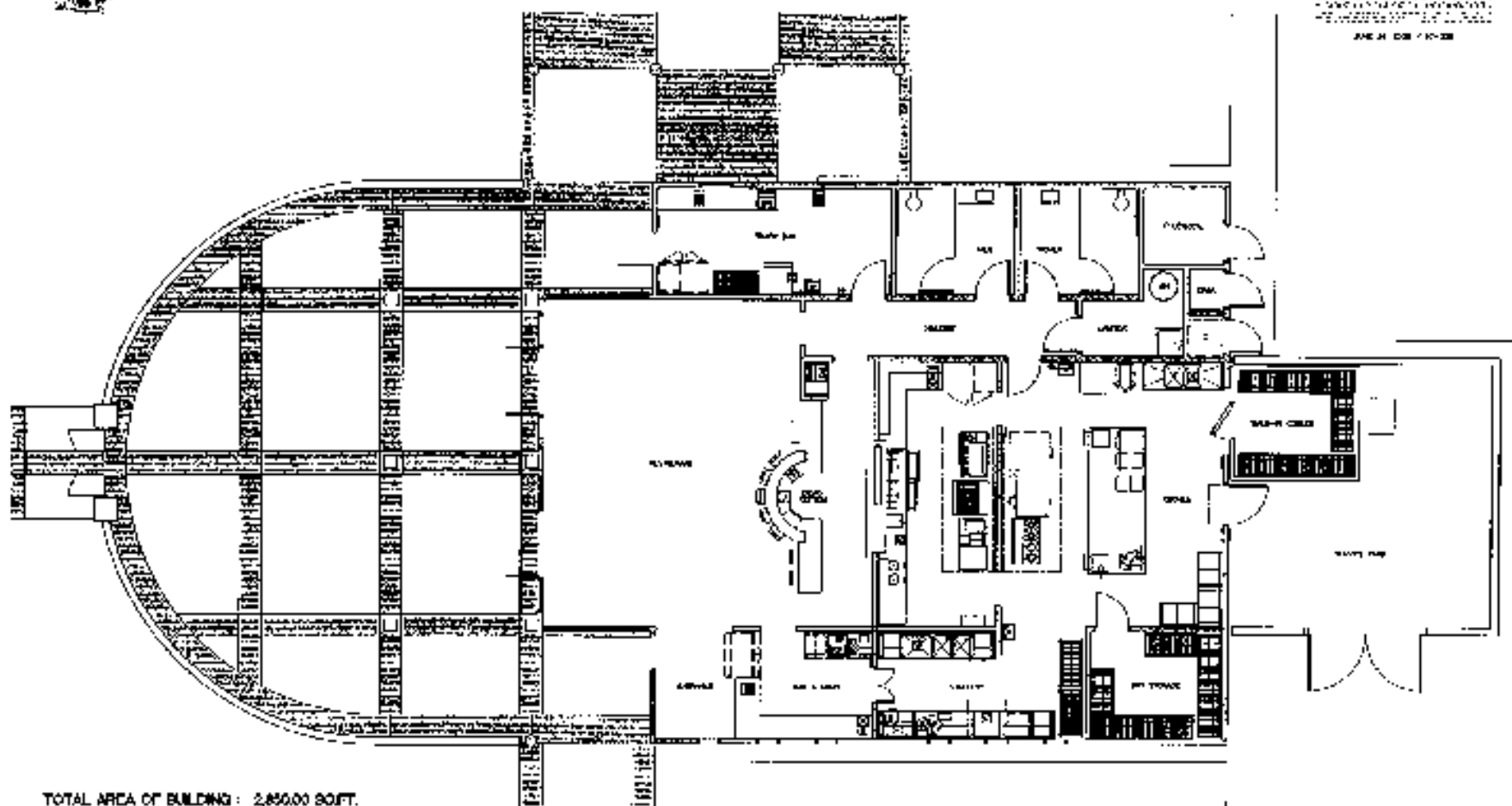






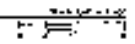

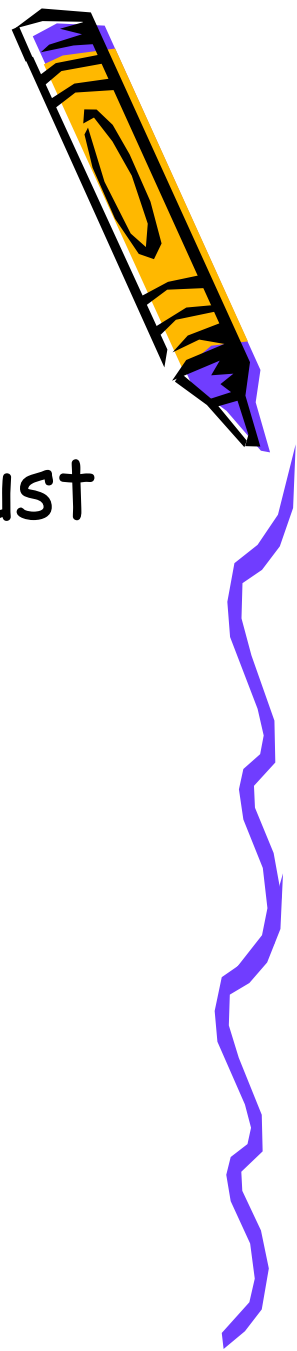
FLOOR PLAN

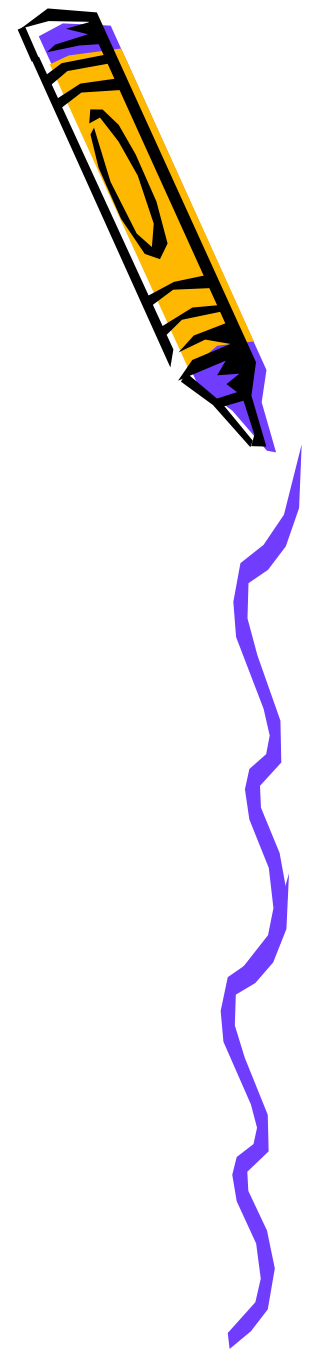
