

COUNTY OF EL DORADO

AMENDMENT TO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into this 1st day of July, 2009, between the State of California, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, referred to herein as, "**CALTRANS**," and the County of El Dorado, hereinafter referred to as, "**COUNTY**."

RECITALS

1. **CALTRANS** and **COUNTY**, pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 130, are authorized to enter into a Cooperative Agreement for improvements to or maintenance of State Highways.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, **CALTRANS** has requested that **COUNTY** assign **COUNTY** employees to perform solid waste and litter abatement along the shoulders of Highways 49 and 193, and in the median of Highway 50 from El Dorado Hills Boulevard East to the east-side of Missouri Flat exit. **COUNTY** has agreed to assign **COUNTY** employees and to provide supervision and direction for those **COUNTY** employees.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED

The parties hereto mutually agree to amend the Cooperative Agreement Number 03A1207 dated August 7, 2006, as follows:

1. **Section III, Paragraph 2, Period of Performance, is amended to read:**

This Agreement shall begin **July 1, 2006**, contingent upon full execution and approval by CALTRANS, and shall expire on **September 30, 2009**, unless extended by amendment.

2. **Section III, Paragraph 5(a.), Cost Limitation, is amended to read:**

The total amount payable by CALTRANS shall not exceed **\$325,000.00**.

3. All other terms and conditions of the original Cooperative Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
