I have just been advised by Mike Applegarth of the CAO that a recommendation will be made to the BOS on Tuesday proposing to essentially eliminate two BOS policies (A-18 and B-10).

There has been no communication with the Grand Jury regarding these recommendations, the latter one of which directly affects the operation of the Grand Jury. Policy A-18 concerns the subject of a Final Report of the 2009-2010 Grand Jury. Policy B-10 directly concerns the operation of the Grand Jury.

It is interesting to me that such a recommendation would be made without any discussion between the CAO Office and the Grand Jury, particularly as regards Policy B-10.

As foreperson of the 2010-2011 Grand Jury I am therefore respectfully request the opportunity to meet with the CAO to discuss what viable alternatives to the current BOS Policy B-10 may be anticipated or proposed PRIOR to the CAO making such a recommendation. I would hope that before the CAO would make such a recommendation to the BOS it would at least communicate with the Grand Jury to enable a basic discussion about impacts and alternatives concerning something so basic to the operation of the Grand Jury.
