SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 5236

ADDING CHAPTER 58 OF
TITLE 5 OF THE
EL DORADO COUNTY
ORDINANCE CODE REGARDING
FILMING PERMITS

On Tuesday, August 19, 2025 the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors approved Ordinance 5236 adding Chapter 58 of Title 5 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code entitled "Filming Permits". The Ordinance updates the process for the orderly issuance and enforcement of permits for filming and photography activity within El Dorado County, including a mechanism for cost recovery and use charges as established by a separate Resolution. The Ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days from passage. The Board of Supervisors also determined that the Ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under §15061(b)(3) in that the Board of Supervisors finds there is no possibility that the implementation of this Ordinance may have significant effects on the environment.
