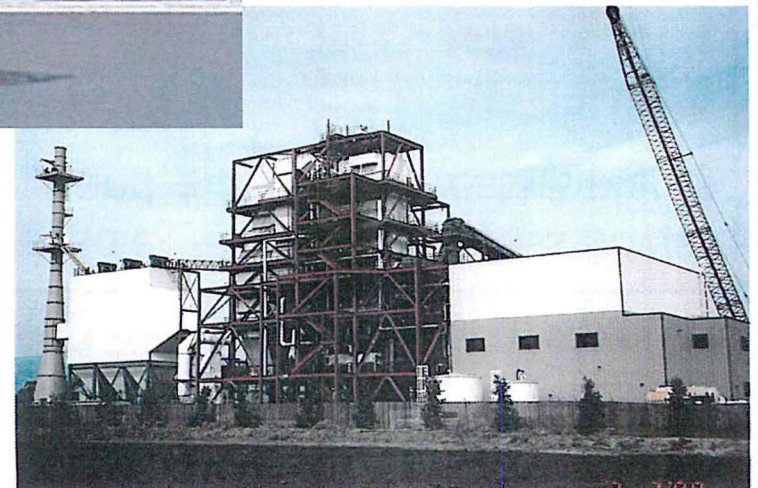

DIGEST : This bill requires that retail sellers procure a statewide total of 500 megawatts (MW) of electricity generated by new geothermal power plants by December 31, 2024.
