**RESOLUTION OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION  
PROGRAMMING LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FUNDS TO  
MATCH AN EL DORADO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BICYCLE  
TRANSPORTATION ACCOUNT GRANT APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Government Code, Title 7.91, Section 67950, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) was created as a local planning agency to provide regional transportation planning for the area of El Dorado County, exclusive of the Lake Tahoe Basin; and

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code Section 29532.1(g) identifies EDCTC as the designated regional transportation planning agency for El Dorado County, exclusive of the Lake Tahoe Basin; and is responsible for the planning, allocating and/or programming of funds; and

**WHEREAS**, EDCTC is responsible for the administration of Transportation Development Act Funds; and

**WHEREAS**, EDCTC has accumulated unprogrammed Transportation Development Act Article 3 Local Transportation Funds (LTF) available for Bicycle and Pedestrian projects; and


**WHEREAS**, in accordance with TDA Statute 99234(a), EDCTC has adopted programming guidelines for use of local bicycle and pedestrian funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the El Dorado County Department of Transportation is submitting a Recreational Trails Program grant application for an extension of the Class I bike path on the El Dorado Trail from Los Trampas Drive to Halcon Road; and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that EDCTC has approved the programming of LTF bicycle and pedestrian funds in the amount of \$62,400 to the El Dorado County Department of Transportation for use as local match for a Recreational Trails Program grant, should grant funding be awarded.
