

El Dorado County Investment to Date



EDCCHC Today

- □ 7,362 clients have a medical home
- □ 56,907 visits provided over 4 years
- □ This year we will see over 5,000 clients in 25,000 visits.

EDCCHC Today


- □ 40% of clients are under age 19
- □ 20% are age 2 or younger
- □ 12% are elderly

At Marshall Hospital:

- □ EDCCHC physicians see all "no doc" babies
- EDCCHC physicians see all "no doc" patients in the ER during the day

EDCCHC as Economic Engine

- □ EDCCHC created 42 new jobs
- □ \$2,000,000 Payroll per year
- □ \$1,000,000 goes to suppliers and vendors
- Each year the Center now generates over \$3 residents million dollars of health care for county



Demand exists:

EDCCHC is largest provider to the targeted 22%,

yet

We are currently serving about 5% of the residents of the County.

98% of Center clients live within 15 miles of center

FQHC Advantage/Disadvantage:

- Advantage: Cost based and reimburses all costs needed to provide services
- Advantage: Long Term Sustainability
- Advantage: on-going annual Grant of \$650,000
- Disadvantage: Does not pay for buildings, equipment or working capital

Therefore:
