- EDA Grant will build middle mile fiber in broadband priority areas of Cool, Georgetown and Garden Valley
- Leverage this success to apply for middle mile fiber in South Lake Tahoe area
- EDA Grant targets Travel, Tourism and Outdoor Recreation infrastructure to improve economic development options
- Partnership with City of South Lake Tahoe, Caltrans, Tahoe Prosperity Center
