



RESOLUTION NO. 105-2025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Sheriff in his capacity as the El Dorado County Director of Emergency Services, did proclaim the local existence of a Local Emergency on August 7, 2024, based on the conditions relating to the Crozier Fire; and

WHEREAS, the County Health Officer did proclaim the existence of a Local Health Emergency on August 8, 2024, based on the conditions relating to the Crozier Fire; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors did find at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 13, 2024 that the aforesaid conditions did warrant and necessitate the recertifications of the Local Emergency and the Local Health Emergency via Resolution Nos. 144-2024 and 145-2024 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has regularly found that the aforementioned state of emergency has continued to exist, based on the recommendations of the Sheriff and County Health Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and County Health Officer both have now concluded that the emergency proclamations are no longer necessary at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said the Local Emergency and Local Health Emergency relating to the Crozier Fire shall be terminated.
