Issue:

El Dorado County Sheriff's Office (ECSO) has requested a one-year extension to purchase and submit their reimbursement request for equipment that they were awarded in Grant Agreement No. C20L0611.

Background:

ECSO was awarded a \$ 100,000.00 equipment grant for the purchase of a patrol boat. The grant agreement No. C20L0611 states that the grantee shall complete their equipment purchases by August 31, 2021 and reimbursement requests are due no later than September 30, 2021. ECSO is requesting an amendment to extend the purchase and reimbursement deadline to September 30, 2022.

Project Status:

This grant agreement was funded on January 4, 2021.

Items for Consideration:

There have been significant delays in manufacturing due to the COVID-19 crisis. ECSO placed orders for the patrol boat but was notified by the vendor, Rogue, that there are still delays in production and shipments due to unprecedented demand and material shortages related to the Coronavirus shutdown. The principal supply line problems effecting the build include the trailer axles and marine engines.

ECSO requests a one-year extension to the purchasing and reimbursement deadlines as outlined in the grant. This extension would change the deadline to purchase the equipment to August 31, 2022 and the deadline to submit the paperwork to September 30, 2022.

Recommendation:

Due to manufacturing and shipping delays caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, staff recommends a one-year extension to purchase and submit a reimbursement request.
