**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**  
**DISSOLUTION OF THE SUNDOWN ESTATES ZONE OF BENEFIT NO. 98378**  
**WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 9**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado formed County Service Area (CSA) No. 9 pursuant to Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 2.2 of the California Government Code and established zones of benefit within CSA No. 9; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board formed the Sundown Estates Zone of Benefit No. 98378 on January 8, 1991, by Resolution 12-91 for the purposes of providing drainage maintenance services; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code section 25217.2, the Board may dissolve a zone of benefit within any county service area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board adopted the County of El Dorado Policy and Procedures Guidelines for Creation and Administration of Zones of Benefit Within a County Service Area, as amended September 10, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held on November 18, 2025 at 9:00 AM and was noticed pursuant to sections 6061 and 25217 of the Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 18, 2025 the Board determined that no majority protest was registered against the dissolution of the zone as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors that:

1. The proposal to dissolve the Sundown Estates Zone of Benefit No. 98378 is made pursuant to sections 25217 and 25217.2 of the Government Code.
2. The boundaries of the zone are described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B.
3. That public interest no longer requires the Sundown Estates Zone of Benefit No. 98378 for the purpose of providing drainage maintenance services.
4. That the extent of any protest against dissolving the zone has been heard and considered at the public hearing.
5. That Sundown Estates has paid all outstanding costs associated with the dissolution proceedings.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, in accordance with the provisions of sections 25217, 25217.1, and 25217.2, of the Government Code, the Sundown Estates Zone of Benefit No. 98378 of County Service Area No. 9 is hereby dissolved; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be recorded and filed with the State Board of Equalization.




