



RESOLUTION NO. 106-2025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Sheriff in his capacity as the El Dorado County Director of Emergency Services, did proclaim the local existence of a Local Emergency on March 3, 2023, based on the conditions relating to the February and March 2023 storms; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors did find at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 7, 2023 that the aforesaid conditions did warrant and necessitate the recertification of the Local Emergency via Resolution No. 045-2023; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has regularly found that the aforementioned state of emergency has continued to exist, based on the recommendation of the Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has now concluded that the emergency proclamation is no longer necessary at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said the Local Emergency relating to the February and March 2023 storms shall be terminated
