Resolution to Support the Request to the California Tahoe Conservancy for Site Improvement Grant Funding for the Sawmill 2B Bike Path and Erosion Control Project

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado (County), through its Department of Transportation, is seeking site improvement grant funding from the California Tahoe Conservancy (CTC) related to the Tahoe Basin Environmental Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS, the County desires to implement the Sawmill 2B Bike Path & Erosion Control Project in the Lake Tahoe South Shore area within the CTC Recreation and Public Access Program and Soil Erosion Control Program (Programs); and,


WHEREAS, the CTC requires certain assurances as part of its Programs, and,


