



SUMMARY OF CHANGES

- Repeal of Ordinance 5210 – An Ordinance Adding Tobacco Retailer Land Use Regulations
 - *Removal of Section 130.40.340 – Tobacco Retailers*
 - *Amendment of Table 130.22.020 – Allowed Uses and Permit Requirements in the Commercial Zones*

Staff recommends the Planning Commission forward a recommendation to the Board to take the following actions:

1. FIND THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE 5210 EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) UNDER SECTION(S) 15060(C)(2) AND 15378 OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES; AND

2. APPROVE REPEALING ORDINANCE 5210 TO AMEND TITLE 130 OF THE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, REPEALING CHAPTER 130.40.340 IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND AMENDING TABLE 130.22.020.
