

CSM (R) Phillip R. Houseworth Biographical Summary

CSM (R) Houseworth, a native of Fremont, California, enlisted in the Regular Army as a Supply Specialist 92Y in 1979.

CSM (R) Houseworth's military education includes Basic Training at Fort Knox, Kentucky, Advanced Individual Training at Fort Lee, Virginia, and the Basic Airborne Course at Fort Benning, Georgia. NCOES courses include the Primary Leadership Development Course, the Basic Non-Commissioned Officers Course, the Advanced Non-Commissioned Officers Course, the First Sergeants Course, and he is a graduate of the Sergeants Major Academy (Class 28). Additional military education includes Infantryman Course 11B, Nuclear Biological and Chemical Course 54B, and Psychological Operation Specialist Course 37F.

His previous positions include United States Army Institute for Military Assistance (USAIMA), Charlie Company 4th/23rd INF, 172nd Infantry Brigade, 104th Training Division, 91st Training Division, 6237th USARF School, HHC 7th Psychological Operations Group, 304th Psychological Operations Company, and the 14th Psychological Operations Battalion.
