



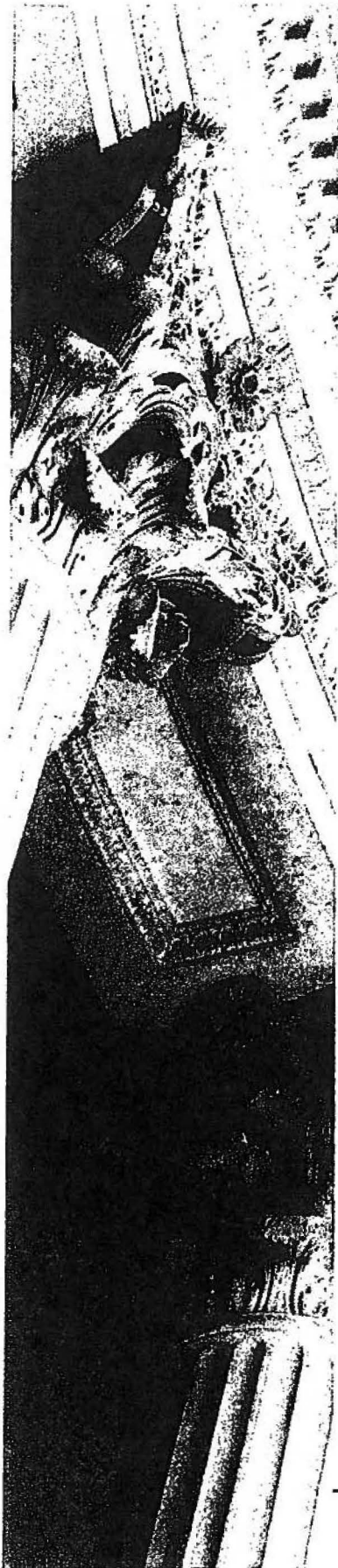

## Overview

Because of your team's interest, expertise and our past success together, CourtView Justice Solutions Inc (CJS) is pleased to offer your organization the opportunity to join a consortium of DAMION Prosecutor and Public Defender customers sponsoring the development of a fully web architected attorney case management solution, JWorks Attorney CM™.

## The Need

There are several compelling forces that have prompted the development of JWorks:

### *Technology*

Over the past several years, the development tools used to create Internet-ready software applications have substantially matured. When combined with the ready availability of high-speed Internet access, continual improvements in hardware, and the relatively low cost of infrastructure, conditions were right for the development of our next generation solution.



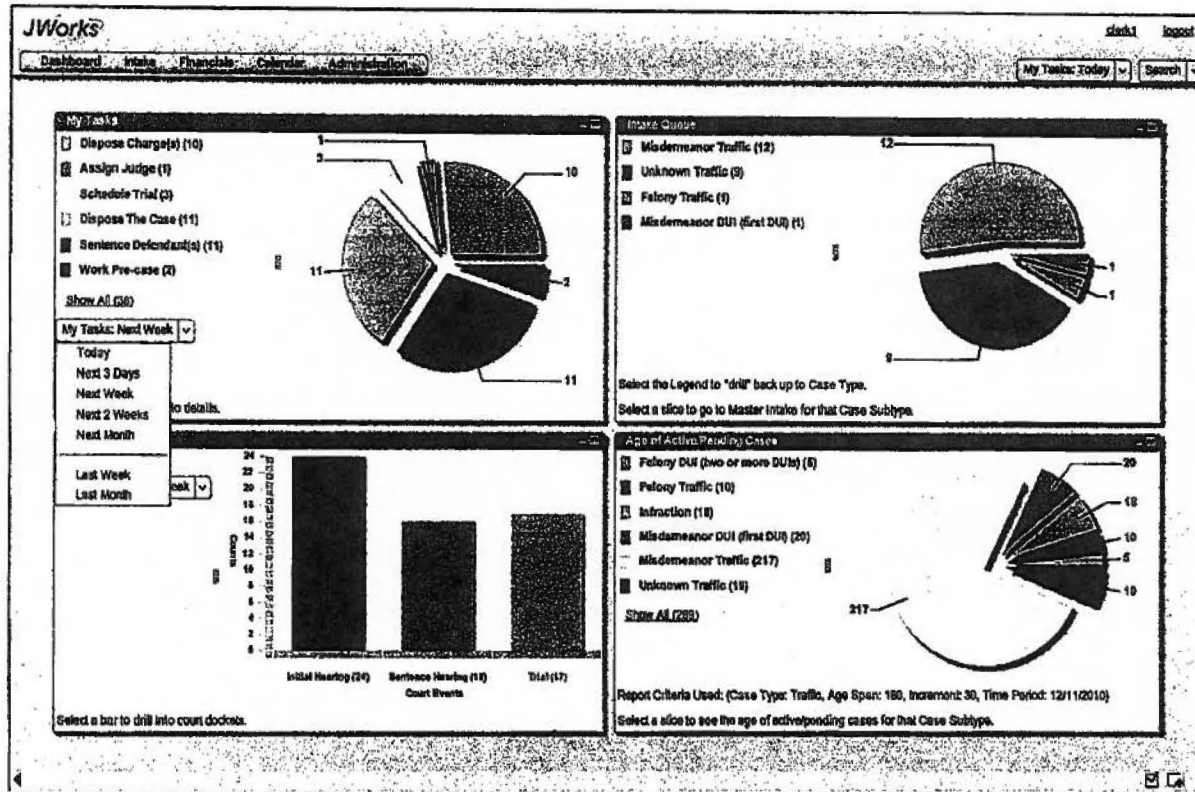
