Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

Approve advanced step placement of a specific Deputy District Attorney III candidate at step 4 of the salary range.

Reason for Recommendation:

The department recently interviewed candidates for the positions of Deputy District Attorney II, III, and IV and has identified a Deputy District Attorney III candidate with entensive experience and is recommending the board authorize the District Attorney to offer employment at step 4 of the salary range.

Because of the imbalance of experienced and inexperienced prosecutors in this office, it is imperative that this new position to be filled by a mid-level, experienced prosecutor, with at least three to five years experience.

The candidate has been a member of the California State Bar since 1999. He has more than seven and a half $(7 \frac{1}{2})$ years of professional experience as an attorney in the state of California and more than four and a half $(4 \frac{1}{2})$ years of professional experience as a criminal prosecutor.

As a prosecutor, he has tried 38 jury trials to verdict. He has been assigned to a felony trial team, a felony law and motion unit, a felony drug unit specializing in asset forfeiture, and has worked as a team leader in a misdemeanor prosecution team. He has conducted Grand Jury proceedings and made filing decisions on both misdemeanor and felony cases.

In addition to his experience as a criminal prosecutor, the candidate has three years of experience as a Senior Associate in a civil litigation law office. In that position he handled all aspects of a multi-million dollar CERCLA (environmental litigation) case in federal court, conducted depositions, and practiced in both state and federal courts.
