**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF
EL DORADO ADOPTING AN AMENDED GENERAL PLAN TRANSPORTATION AND
CIRCULATION ELEMENT REMOVING THE CONCEPTUAL HEADINGTON ROAD ALIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2004, the Board of Supervisors adopted the 2004 El Dorado County General Plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2015, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Target General Plan Amendment and Zoning Ordinance Update that included adoption of Figure TC-1, the Circulation Map for the El Dorado County General Plan; and

WHEREAS, an application to amend the General Plan to remove the conceptual Headington Road alignment from Figure TC-1, the Circulation Map, was filed on October 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, applications to change the Zoning of the project site, to revise the Planned Development Permit, and to authorize a Conditional Use Permit for the Crossings – El Dorado RV Resort and Campground project were filed on January 20, 2023; and

WHEREAS, an Addendum to the Environmental Impact Report was prepared identifying modified mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Consultation was solicited under SB 18 and the County received no request for Consultation and is now closed; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2025 the Planning Commission held a meeting on this project and recommended approval; now

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors authorizes the following amendment to the General Plan:

- Remove the Conceptual Headington Road Alignment from Figure TC-1 the Circulation Map for the El Dorado County General Plan as depicted in Exhibit A.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Planning and Building Director to work with the County Surveyor to make conforming revisions to pages 2 and 3 of Figure TC-1 following amendment to the General Plan.

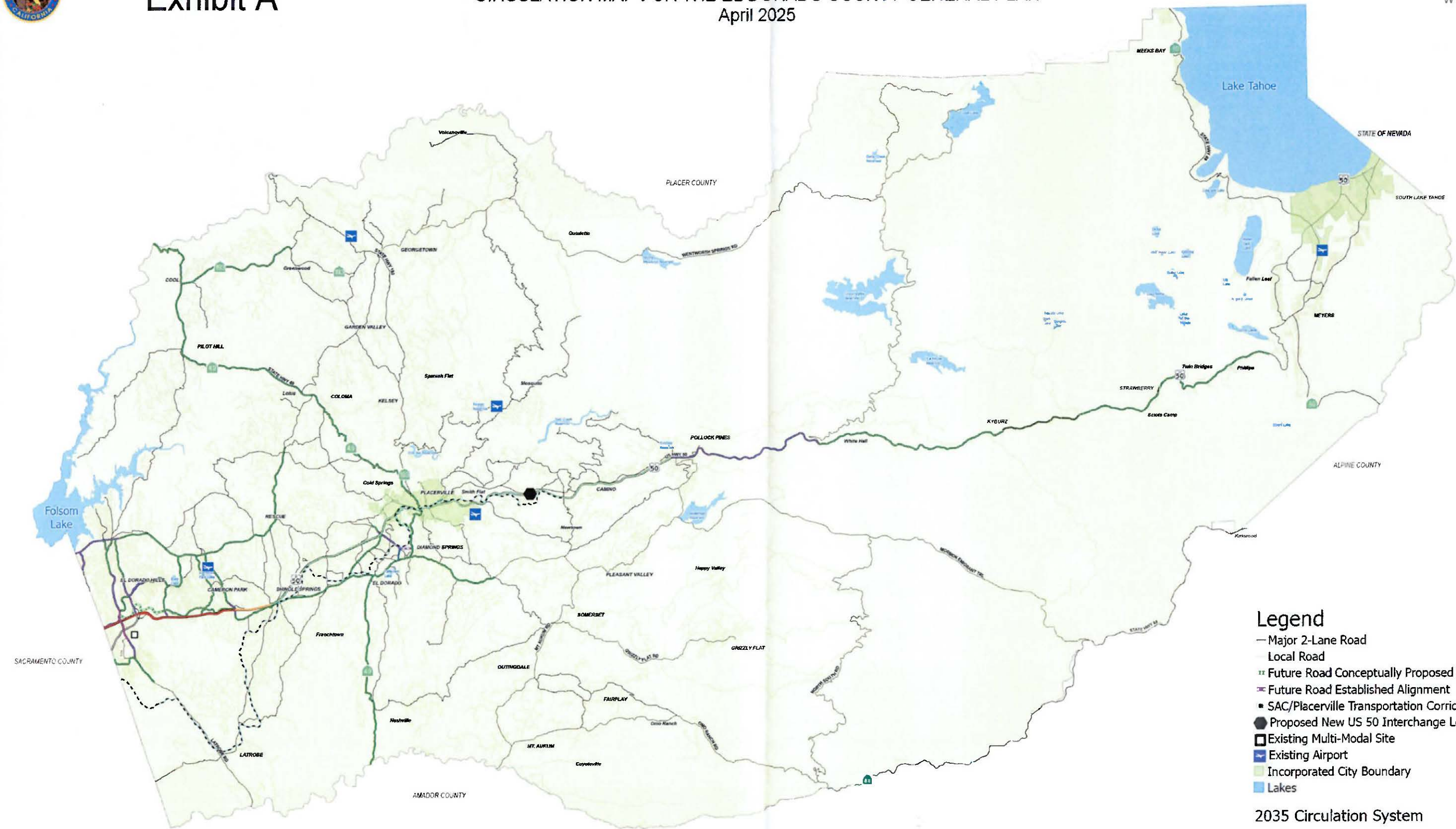
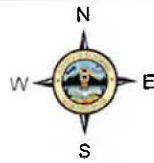
