


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## LAKEGILINK - Ridership, By Trip Purpose

Pickups Heat Map








- Highly successful, totally funded outside the Tahoe Transportation District
- 122,000+ riders Yr1, Est. 200,000 Yr2
- 12,000+ are using Lake Link every month, 24,000 in January 2024 alone
- El Dorado County contributed \$300K in 2022, and \$200K 2023

#### **Survey Data**

- There is no transit for the everyday person in this portion of El Dorado County beside Paratransit
- Survey Data of 450 that responded, 80% said they would use transit
- 60% said they were willing to walk up to ½ mile to transit service
- Vast majority would use transit to access recreation in the summer

#### **Meyers Service Options**





### Longer Term – South Lake Tahoe (Map 3) Partial – Details

- Eight service area zones are being assessed in the SRTP
- Extension of Rt 50 to Kingsbury
- Extension of 50 to Round Hill (subject to demand)
- · Service to Zephyr Cove from Stateline/Kingsbury
- Extend East Shore Express to Spooner/Summit
- Subject to demand, Convert Gardnerville service to a schedule service and extend to Minden Following existing DART alignment
- Reinstate schedule commuter service to Carson City via Hwy 50 to connect with JAC Rt 3 at Park and Ride
- Kingsbury Mobility Hub (integrate with Hospital and event center development)
- Long term Round Hill Mobility Hub development



### LAKE LINK Funding as of February 2024 and Beyond

- \$2.2M CY24 raised by existing P3 funding partners (EDC, \$200K)
- \$3.8M required for citywide service
- Future Additional Funding Options for sustainable citywide transit service and surrounding portions of El Dorado County not well served by TTD: FTA, State Transportation Development Act Funding, P3 partners (evaluating TOT, TBID, or Equivalent); Prefer Local Control of Existing TDA Funds ~\$2.2M \$2.5M
- **Joint Powers Authority** suggested to secure local control and claim the TDA funding and explore becoming direct recipient of Federal, State funding in the future.

### LAKE LINK Future El Dorado County Service Options

- First Step Establish local control
- Explore Options to expand existing Paratransit Service for Meyers residents by expanding Microtransit on-demand
- Explore limited stop bus service from Meyers to The Y transit hub
- Explore service to Emerald Bay
- Explore options to enhance El Dorado Transit Authority bus service frequency (Amtrak Route)
