OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Resolution to Support the Request to the California Tahoe Conservancy for Implementation Grant Funding for the South Tahoe Greenway - Upper Truckee River Bridge at Johnson Meadow Project

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado (County), through its Department of Transportation, is seeking implementation grant funding from the California Tahoe Conservancy (CTC) related to the Tahoe Basin Environmental Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS, the County desires to construct the South Tahoe Greenway - Upper Truckee River Bridge at Johnson Meadow Project building upon the Dennis T. Machida Memorial Greenway shared use path network through the south shore of Lake Tahoe within the State of California's Proposition 4 Grant Program (Program); and,

WHEREAS, the CTC requires grant applications to include a resolution by the governing body confirming the applicant's commitment to the project(s) and to operate and maintain the funded facility for its useful life; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, that the County supports the Program; the County supports the request to the CTC for funding the proposed work in the Tahoe Basin; and, if the County is awarded the subject grant funding, the County will agree to implement the project in a manner consistent with the Programs' objectives and to operate and maintain the project improvements over its useful life following completion of construction.
