<u>Title</u>: Resolution Recognizing Volunteer Contributions to Human Services and Authorizing Expenditures for Ongoing Volunteer Appreciation Activities

Recommendations:

Human Services recommends that the Board adopt a Resolution recognizing the significant contributions made by volunteers in the provision of human services in El Dorado County and authorizing the Department of Human Services to expend of up to \$1,500 each fiscal year for provision of volunteer recognition and appreciation activities, some of which may not fall within the parameters recognized as being usual business expenditures, including the purchase of food and supplies for events and tokens of appreciation such as plaques, certificates and pins, including specific costs associated with events celebrating the contributions of volunteers in the Senior Day Care, Senior Nutrition and other Senior Programs.

Reasons for Recommendations:

In America, volunteerism is recognized as having a significant beneficial impact on both the volunteers and the recipients of their efforts. National Volunteer Recognition Week was initiated in 1974 and continues to be proclaimed annually as a time to say "thank you" to the millions of people who make a difference by volunteering their time and expertise to help others. In adopting the Older Americans Act, Congress recognized the need for socialization for elder citizens to help them remain alert and independent to the extent possible, requiring only that individuals be age 60+ to participate in these federally funded services, with no income eligibility requirements. Volunteering provides socialization for both the giver and recipient of services. Certain programs, such as the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program, are volunteer-based by design and receive funding allocated specifically for volunteer support. The Older Californian's Act authorizes Community Based Services Programs, which likewise encourage volunteer involvement. Volunteer hours are claimed as in-kind matching contributions to federal and state grant funds. Locally, volunteers play a key role in the provision of services provided by the Department of Human Services to vulnerable population groups, especially seniors. Many programs, including Senior Nutrition, Senior Activities and Senior Day Care, could not function without the assistance of dedicated volunteers, who may deliver meals to homebound seniors one, two or more times weekly, use their expertise to instruct classes or provide assistance in a myriad of other ways. Many Senior Day Care volunteers have logged thousands of hours in helping the Center to offer a pleasant, enriching environment for its members by providing entertainment, leading activities or just plain being there.

The attached chart clearly demonstrates the significance of volunteer contributions to the provision of Human Services programs. The attached spreadsheet reflects the hours contributed by volunteers to provision of Senior Day Care services and itemizes expenditures totaling \$344.48 for the April 17, 2007 volunteer recognition event.

The use of volunteers has been an integral component of services provided by the Department of Human Services for nearly three decades. By adoption of this Resolution, the Board authorizes the Department of Human Services to continue to expend small sums of budgeted dollars for various volunteer appreciation purchases and activities each year. Please note that funds for Older Americans Day activities are budgeted separately.

Fiscal Impact:

Human Services proposes to expend no more than \$1,500 in budgeted donation revenues annually to express appreciation for the invaluable services provided by its volunteers.

Net County Cost: No change.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

Board Clerk to provide Human Services, Community Services Division, with two (2) Certified Resolutions.
