



RESOLUTION NO. 026-2022

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**WHEREAS**, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the El Dorado County Criminal Attorneys' Association (Association), representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit have met and negotiated in good faith since October 27, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Association representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit have held election(s) and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding; and,

**WHEREAS**, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and the Association representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit expired June 30, 2021, and the County of El Dorado and the Association are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves, adopts, and authorizes the Chair to sign this Resolution and the successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the El Dorado County Criminal Attorneys' Association, representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.
