

#### 2026 PROPOSED SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY RATE INCREASES

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at 10:00 am on Tuesday, June 23, 2026, by the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors, which will be held at the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 330 Fair Lane, Building A, Placerville, California. The public hearing will consider the request by El Dorado Disposal Service to have an interim year solid waste collection rate increase of 4.12% for Franchise Areas A, B, and C, and for the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) to be effective, July 1, 2026.
