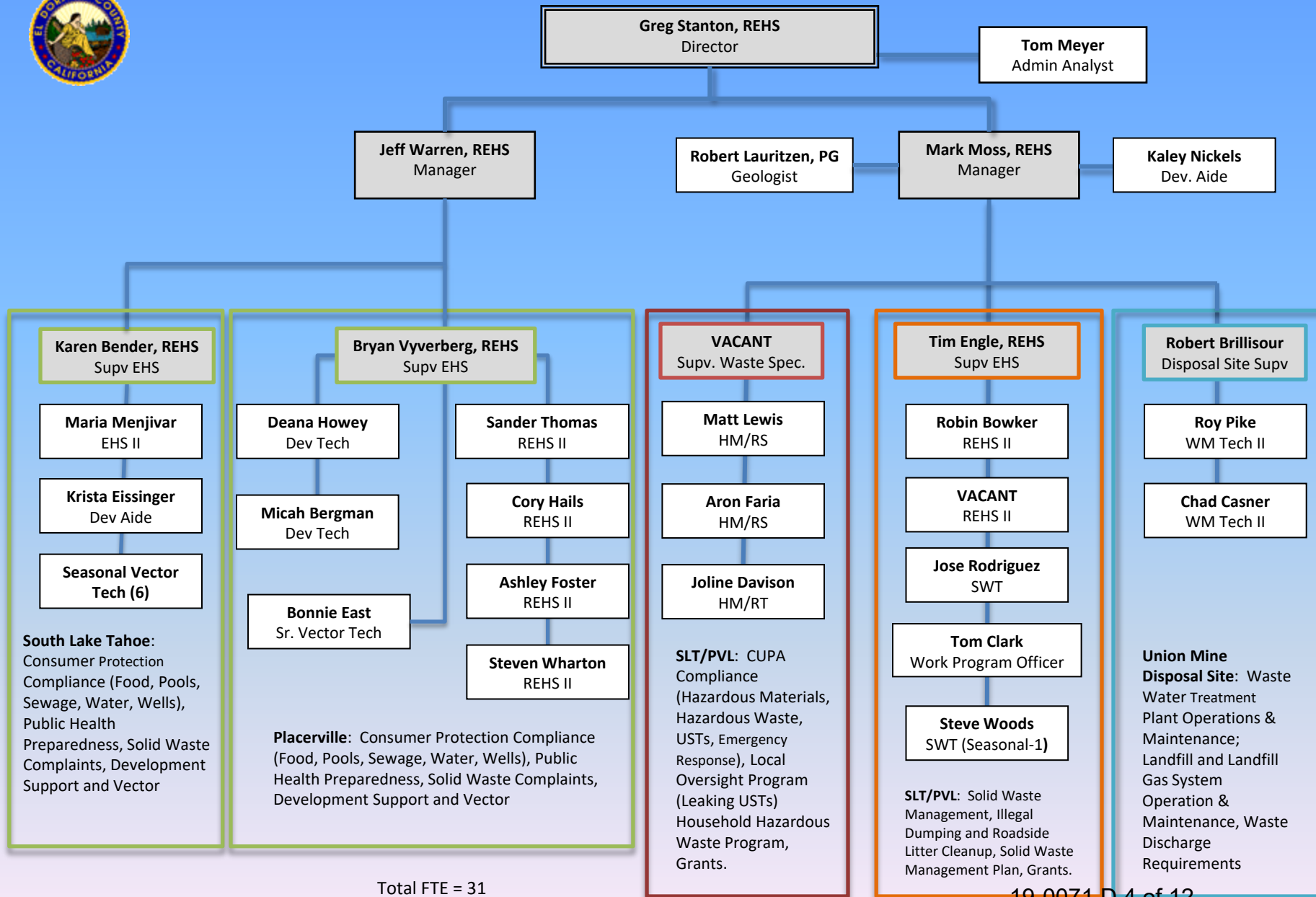




# MISSION STATEMENT

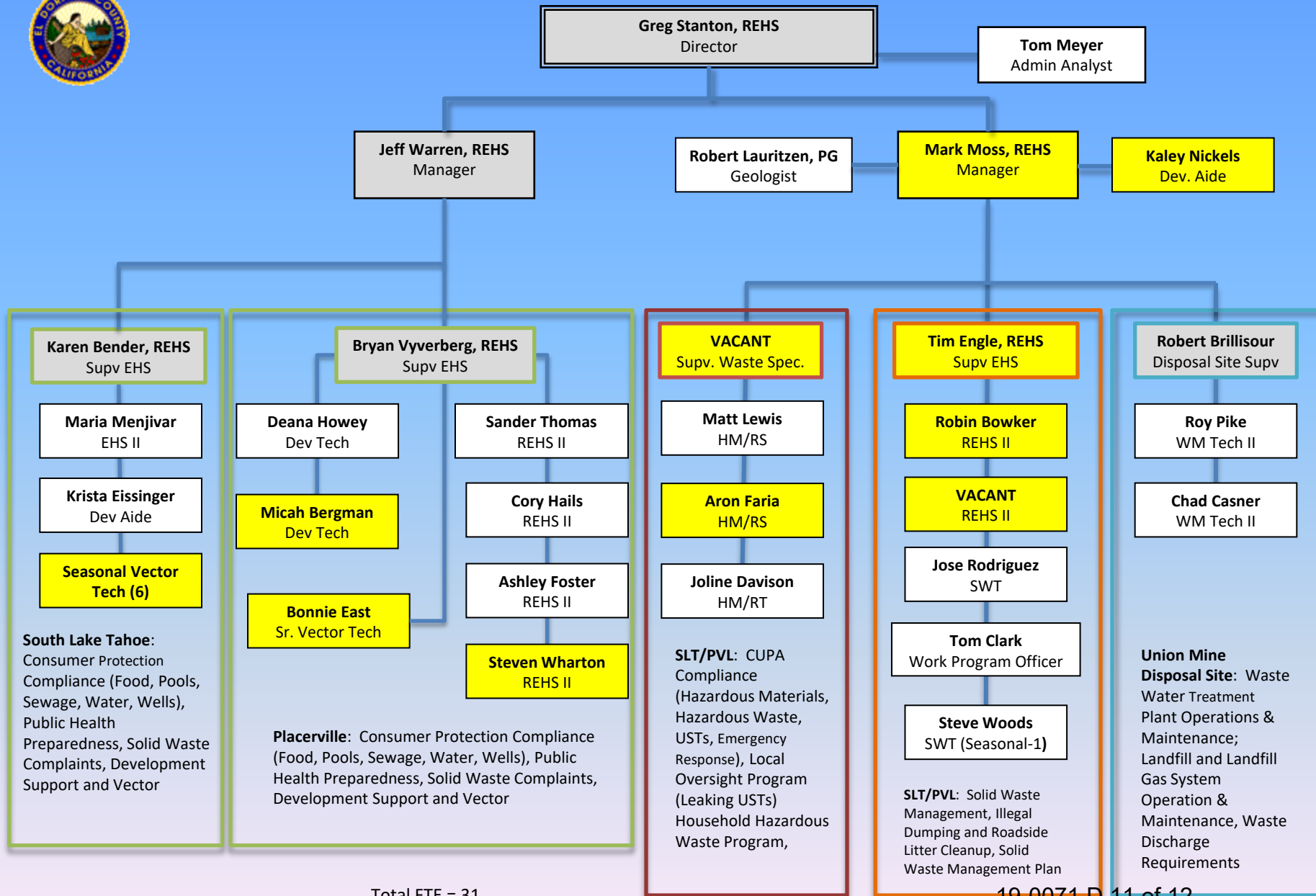
