

Dear Board Chair Hidahl and Members of the EDC Board of Supervisors:

We fully support Supervisor Hidahl's recommendation (Agenda Item 21-0906) to approve and authorize the proposed letter from the EDC Board of Supervisors to the Budget committees in both the California State Senate and Assembly in support of Governor Newsom's proposed \$7 billion investment to expand broadband infrastructure.
