

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Construction of erosion control improvements including tree removal, curb and gutter with tie-in pavement, sediment traps, drainage inlets, culverts, headwalls, rock-lined-channel, and infiltration trenches. These improvements are proposed for construction on the following streets: Tooch Street, Nadowa Street, Susquehana Drive, Jicarilla Drive, Aravaipa Street, Pioneer Trail, and Muskwaki Drive.		
LOCATION OF PROJECT: In the Tahoe Basin in El Dorado County, east of U.S. Highway 50, and west of Pioneer Trail. The Project area generally is bounded by Pioneer Trail on the southeast, Trout Creek to the east, and the Upper Truckee River and the rescinded Caltrans highway corridor to the west. The Project area includes Tahoe Paradise Additions Nos. 2, 4 & 5.		
PORTIONS OF THE PROJECT TO WHICH THIS NOTICE APPLIES: All work specified in the Contract Documents dated March 2008, and Contract Change Orders 1-6.
