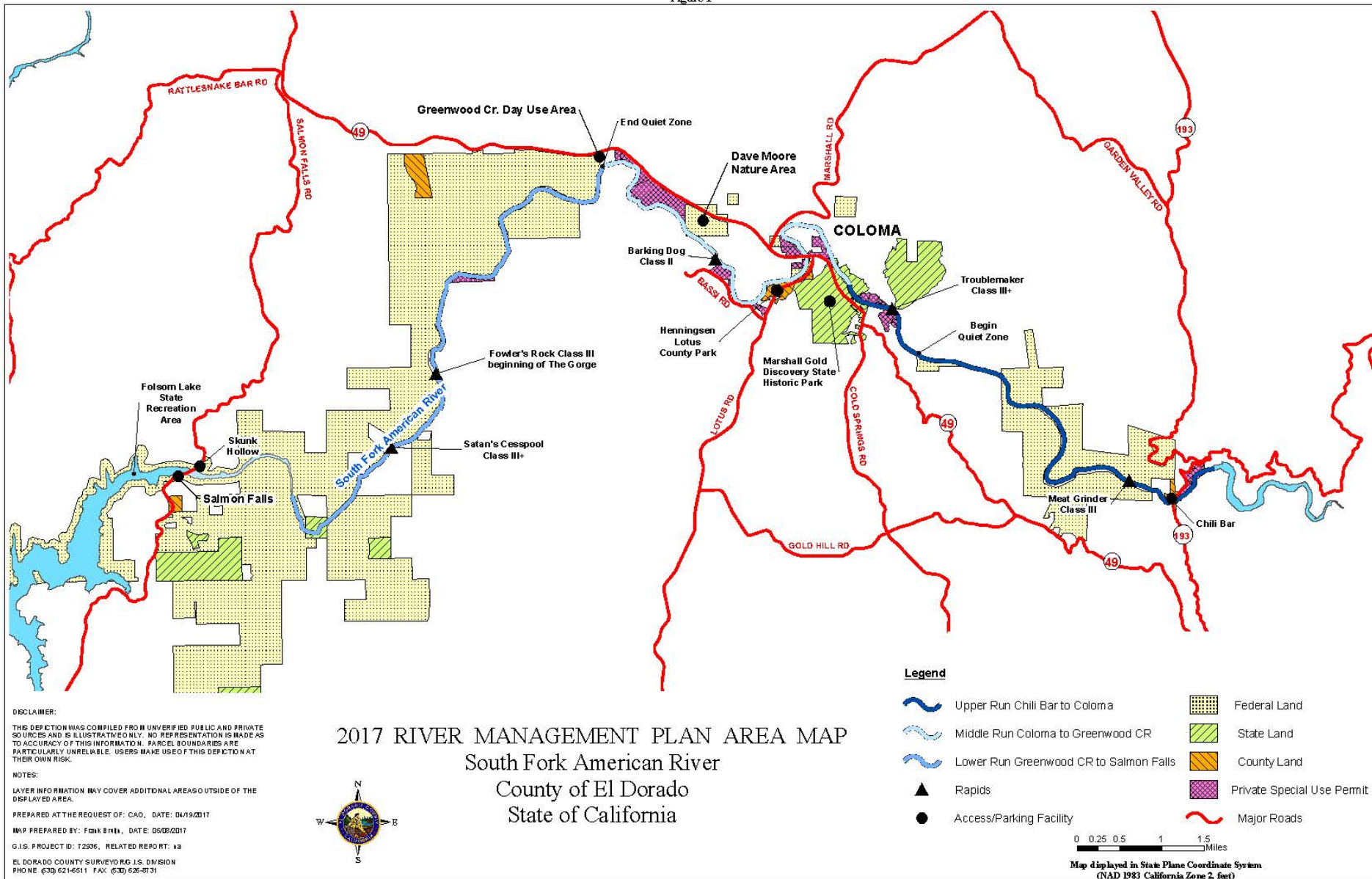

Consultant Recommendations

- Reconsider the County's Management of Whitewater Recreation
- Delegate the Management of Commercial Outfitters to a State or Federal Agency
- Use the County's GIS as the Clearinghouse for Outfitter Data

Consultant Recommendations

- The RMP Needs to be Streamlined
- Dissolve the RMAC
- Update the RMP every 3 years

Consultant Recommendations

- Reduce the RMP Position to a Seasonal or Half-Year Assignment
- Create a User-Day Marketplace for Commercial User Days or Enforce Current Regulations
- Address the Management of Institutional User Groups
- End RMP Water Quality Sampling Programs

Proposed RMP Element Changes

- Removes processes that are no longer relevant
- Removes Regulations that are unenforceable or currently being regulated/enforced by another County Department
- Removes Water Sampling that duplicates the work of others

Proposed RMP Element Changes

- Changes to guide requirements and outfitter regulations to streamline reporting
- Revises management strategies to mirror other BLM and State Parks processes
- Adds High Water Condition regulations

Proposed RMP Element Changes

- Outfitter Subcontracting regulations added
- Boat spacing requirements added

Proposed RMP Element Changes

- Private boater requirements regarding safety and environmental impacts revised
- Provides clarification of commercial and institutional group definitions

Proposed Next Steps

- CEQA Project Description Hearing at July 2017 Planning Commission Meeting
- CEQA Project Description Hearing at July 2017 Board of Supervisors Meeting
- CEQA Initial Study Document to be Prepared in August 2017
