Event/Project Description

1. Describe the purpose of the event/project/organization for which funds are being requested. The Community Center was built in the late 1940s/early 1950s and the bathrooms reflect their age. Additionally, they are not in compliance with current Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) and must be updated to better accommodate all our community members. Plus, we could be subject to fines and penalties if a disabled person were to file a complaint with the federal government for our non-compliance. We've been accumulating funding to do this for the past few years, but most of it had to be spent for taxes, insurance, and utilities to keep the center operational during the Covid lock down when we were unable to host events or rent out the facility.
