Re: Bass Lake Road Improvements

Please consider the least invasive and out of the way detour for the upcoming Bass Lake Road Improvement project road realignment.

Rerouting the daily traffic thru the planned Easterly Detour via Country Club Drive to Hollow Oak Drive, is not a viable option.

The westerly reroute thru Silver Dove road is more favorable and less invasive to the daily traffic flows.

Try looking at a parallel route adjacent to the realignment as a temporary means during the construction.

Considering the amount of daily traffic, and the potential delays to emergency services to use alternate routes in times of need, I think that the Board of Supervisors should be practical and understanding to the needs of the community when voting and considering the various options.
