Note: Recycling services at this local family event are provided by South Tahoe Refuse, through their Special Event Recycling Program. STR staff monitors the blue recycling containers placed throughout the event during the day and consolidates and transports the recyclables to the STR MRF for processing. STR also works on the event planning committee with Lake Valley Fire Department and other federal, state and local fire agencies.

STR collects furniture at the Transfer Station to be used during a home sprinkler demonstration at the event.

Jugs of tap water are available at the event to refill reusable water bottles and to encourage the "Drink Tahoe Tap" campaign. South Tahoe Public Utility District gave away toddler size reusable water bottles at this event in 2017 while STR gave away reusable grocery bags.

Recyclable weights are included in the MRF section totals.

Note: South Tahoe Refuse is a Sample the Sierra sponsor and provides the staff and resources to do zero waste at this annual event. In 2017 four stations were set-up with containers for food waste, recyclables and trash. STR staff manned these station throughout the event, providing education to participants on the benefits of diverting organic and recyclable materials from the wastestream. Tap water in water jugs was also provided throughout the event to refill single use and reusable water bottles, reducing the purchase of more plastic water bottles at the event. STR staff collected the materials and transported them to the STR MRF for recycling and the STR RRF for food waste composting. Weights are included in the MRF and RRF sections.

Describe plan and timeline for implementing the plan:

The organizers of this seventh year event used South Tahoe Refuse's Material Recovery Facility recycling services for this event. This was comprised of 6-yard and 33-yard dumpsters disbursed throughout the event. Recyclables and trash were transferred to the dumpsters by event staff throughout this three day event. After the event, the dumpsters were picked up by STR and sorted at their Material Recovery Facility. The tons diverted are included in the section discussing MRF recycling. The waste management plan also encouraged the sale of re-usable water bottles and water re-fill stations to reduce the amount of plastic bottle waste.

To what extent has the venue/event implemented its written plan or informal diversion/recycling activities?

51-75% Implemented

Note: A subcontractor with considerable experience was hired by the event producers again this year to coordinate mixed recycling and food waste recycling. The results were an improvement as it provided visible, on-site, source separation for recyclables and food waste, but a lack of supervision lead to contamination problems with the source separated materials.

Describe plan and timeline for implementing the plan:

The South Shore Earth Day event is a "zero waste" event. Food vendors are required to use compostable tableware. Earth Day volunteers man recycling/composting/waste stations and educate the public on reducing waste. South Tahoe Refuse provides containers for recycling and composting and pick up services. Recyclables are processed by South Tahoe Refuse, compostable materials is processed by Full Circle Compost and waste is minimized. There are no charges for STR or Full Circle Compost services for this event.

A Bike Valet is provided to encourage "pedal power" coming to the event.

Information on Mandatory Commercial and Apartment recycling was provided at this year's event along with materials on recycling and other sustainable programs at multiple booths.

The crafts for the Kid's Zone were all based from recycled materials, such a toilet paper rolls and egg cartons.

To what extent has the venue/event implemented its written plan or informal diversion/recycling activities?

76-100% Implemented

Note: Each year the zero waste aspect of this annual event improves. Originally implemented in 2004, organizing of the stations has improved each year and education of the public has increased with practiced volunteers. The members of the California Conservation Corps manned the education stations in 2017 and promoted the concept and potential of reducing food waste by composting. The compostable materials are delivered to Full Circle Compost for processing. Recyclable materials are sorted at the STR MRF. Food vendors are now supportive of the zero-waste program and provide their own compostable tableware. Jugs of tap water are provide throughout the event to refill re-usable water bottles, reinforcing the "Drink Tahoe Tap" campaign. Crafts for the Kid's Zone use recycled materials.

Four stations are set up throughout the event for food waste, recycling and trash. STR employees provide information and education on the value of recycling and composting. The event includes booths by well over 100 local businesses so it's a great opportunity to get people interested in these programs. Casino staff are not involved in the zero waste efforts, so the implementation is not quite what it could be. Mixed recycling is sorted at the STR MRF and food waste goes to Full Circle Compost for processing. Tonnages are included in the MRF and food waste recycling sections.
