This letter is to inform you and follow up regarding a meeting with representatives from the El Dorado County Chief Administrative Officer's office, Long Range Planning Division, Economic Development Department, and Shingle Springs Community Alliance (SSCA) on Friday October 25, 2013.

At the meeting, several ideas and options were discussed regarding how to move forward with creating and implementing the Shingle Springs Community Plan. SSCA has held several community meetings to engage the public in the process and there is an Outreach Plan currently being created to further the outreach to as many people and entities as possible. At the June 5, 2013 Community Meeting, attendees were given the opportunity to complete two surveys: one was to gather input on design guidelines for commercial and multi-family residential projects in our town core area, and the other was to gather input regarding general concepts to include in the Community Plan.
